Summary of Enhancements – Host

- New “Waiting Room” feature. When participants connect to your meeting they automatically enter the Waiting Room – a list of participants who are waiting to join your meeting. The presenter can "lock" the meeting by choosing not to be notified if someone is late. The presenter, however, has the option of entering the Waiting Room at any time to accept latecomers to the meeting.
- The Meeting Manager and Waiting Room are not displayed to participants. This can be toggled on or off from the View menu.
- The Participant Panel has been improved. There are now 2 columns of participant entries in the panel, which grows dynamically so that all participants are in view.
- Now, only one participant can have keyboard/mouse control at one time. The mouse column is gone from the list and replaced by a "Give Control" button. To take back control, the presenter simply right-clicks anywhere on his screen.
- The chat panel now sizes independently of the participant panel. "Everyone" option is not present in the "Send To" drop down when only one participant is connected.
- The VOIP panel is easier to use. VOIP now multicasts for better performance.
- The Meeting Manager has a new look. You'll now experience high-color headers, a silver textured background, and high-resolution icons.
- The Meeting Manager menus have been redesigned. The new Participants menu includes operations which act on all participants. Now you can give or take away a tool from ALL participants at once.
- The host now indicates if there's a host update available. When a software update is available, an information icon on your System Tray will appear when participants aren't connected. Upon left-clicking the icon, the host update wizard is invoked.

Summary of Enhancements – Client/Viewer

- New Meeting Tools Panel. Participants can now view a list and conduct real-time text messaging with the other attendees in the meeting. This allows for private messaging between presenter & participant, or a participant with another participant.
- The presenter can now grant and revoke keyboard/mouse control from a participant at any time.
- The client viewer now centers on the primary display. If you are running Windows dual monitors, the viewer centers on the primary monitor.

How to Update

To update the eBLVD Host software, click on the eBLVD icon in the system tray and select 'Check for Host Updates'. An update wizard will open. Follow the prompts to update the Host software.
